Essential requirements <i>To be identified through:</i> -Application Form -University Student Record	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> You must have a valid passport and be able to secure a visa for the allocated country. You must be a campus-based, undergraduate (Level 4 or 5) or postgraduate student at Birmingham City University. You must be enrolled and returning to study in September 2017. Distance learning students are not eligible to apply. You must currently hold a 2:2 average or higher in your degree. You must be able to attend the full schedule of the Outgoing Summer School Overseas programme you are applying for. You must be prepared to cover any additional personal expenses such as food, flights, visa and health/accident insurance costs if applicable. Please contact the International Office for further details of what is included. You may be eligible for a further scholarship through your Faculty, please contact your Faculty for further information.
Desirable requirements <i>To be identified through:</i> -Personal Statement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Interest in learning about different cultures. Participation in extracurricular activities at Birmingham City University. Variety of skills and interests. Willingness to learn new skills. Enthusiasm about and willingness to act as an ambassador of Birmingham City University during and following your return to participate in the promotion of the programme. Awareness of partner institution and host country. Personal or work experience overseas. Knowledge of the benefits and what you may gain if you are successful in achieving a place.
